Moultonborough Summer Informational Set for July 23rd.

As the kick-off item of its workshop of July 23rd, the Moultonborough SelectBoard will host the 2009 Summer Informational Session. The session will begin at 4 p.m. in the Ernest Davis Meeting Room of the Town Hall located at 6 Holland Street. Previously held on a Saturday morning to a low turnout, the SelectBoard is trying this format to leave people to enjoy the entirety of their weekend.

The session will be moderated by Town Moderator Mel Borrin. It will start with a short presentation by the Town's Community Services Team (Human Services, Visiting Nurses, and Recreation Departments) on their recent and upcoming activities focused on the expansion of services for seniors. This will be followed by a Question and Answer session on community issues in general.

“While our year round residents can attend meetings on a regular basis and come into Town Hall at any time, this time has been designed especially for our seasonal residents” said Karel Crawford, Chairman of the Board of Selectmen. She went on to note, “Our recent, well attended, seminar on the Comprehensive Shoreline Protection Act (CSPA) was a direct response to a request from a seasonal resident at our 2008 session.”
